Think less about the camera settings to concentrate more on composition, framing, and the scene.



Setting your ISO 1600 will give you a fast shutter speed to get a sharper scene for subjects in motion. A high ISO will give you the ability to capture a sharper scene.





- Compensate for slow autofocus:
- Use center-point autofocus.
- Turn on the "High Autofocus" performance mode on the settings.

Keep the camera in single-shot.
